


Industry Update – 27 330 days of response

17th May 2023

Varroa Response Update

The total confirmed infected premises is now 156. There has been one new IP in the west Lake Macquarie area and one in Sedgefield east of Singleton, these have been from DPI surveillance and confirmed through the laboratory. These were within the PURPLE zones and close to the edge of the existing RED zones. As a result it will extend the RED zone south and west of the Newcastle complex.

Operations continue to focus on first round surveillance of the PURPLE zones, which is on schedule, as reported last update and expected to reach completion end of May. The cooperation of industry and the community is vital in helping the response achieve the goal of eradication.



Wild European Honeybee Baiting Program

The WEHB Program is well underway across several of the RED zones with a surge in staffing and deployment of over 600 feeder stations more recently, with an average of over 90% of these stations being successfully spiked. The stations are currently laid out across Central Coast, West Newcastle, Bulahdelah, Wards River, Wherrol Flat and Krambach and are at different stages of their feeding and spiking cycles. Sentinel hives are also deployed in the Central Coast RED zone and have shown efficacy of the spiking of bait stations nearby, the data continues to be gathered in this region while baiting is currently ongoing.
