## **INDUSTRY NOTICE:** 1 cent Levy Increase to Repay Varroa Response Implemented

## To the Australian Honey Bee Industry Levy Payers,

The Australian Honey Bee Industry Council (AHBIC) wishes to inform industry levy payers the 1 cent increase in the Emergency Plant Pest Response Deed (EPPRD) levy has come into effect from 1st July 2025.

In November 2024 honey levy payers were invited to participate in an objection period for proposed changes to honey levies. We want to advise that the feedback was addressed and those changes have now been made in the Regulations.
